Graduate 365 Developer at Langley Waterproofing - Responsibilities include maintaining Dynamics 365 CRM systems, developing new customisations as requested by the company, monitoring the internal helpdesk and providing first level support to employees, alongside the rest of the IT department. As part of this role, I helped to develop the 'Knowledge Hub' for the internal technical department: made up of a set of HTML web resources, which uses JavaScript to interact with the CRM database using APIs. I have also developed several bespoke components to add into this including an FAQ system, a comparison system akin to those found on sites such as Curry's PC World and a library of viewable documents. Finally, I have styled the entire thing using CSS and Bootstrap components to make it responsive and branded appropriately. ~ June 2022 to May 2024

More recently, I have also assisted in developing a new HR platform using the Power Platform and Dynamics 365, to replace the use of Finance and Operations as our organisation-wide HR solution. During this project, I not only gained further experience using the dynamics platform to develop the data structure required for the backend of the system, but also created a Power Pages portal to serve as a self-service frontend. Creating the portal taught me a variety of new skills including how to add custom JS and CSS to a portal in order to gain complete control over how it looks and functions. I feel I have a better grasp on Power Pages after this project. ~ January 2024 – September 2025
